Abington Township Thanks First Responders for Heroic Efforts on SPS Technologies Fire

ABINGTON, PA: Abington Township would like to extend its **deepest gratitude** to the courageous emergency responders who tirelessly battled the SPS Technologies fire for **114 consecutive hours** beginning February 17 and ending February 22, 2025, at 3:53 PM.

This unprecedented fire required an extensive and around-the-clock emergency response; a response that demonstrated the extraordinary courage, strength, professionalism, training, capabilities, and commitment to service of our first responders at the local, county, state and federal levels. Their relentless efforts and dedication ensured the safety of our and surrounding communities and minimized the damage caused by this devastating incident.

We recognize the sacrifices made by these responders, including long hours, extreme conditions, and the risks they faced to protect lives and property. We would also like to acknowledge their families and their sacrifice, strength, and support throughout the entire incident.
