Green Program

Abington Township Green is a separtate fund designed by the Township to accept donations for the purpose of purchasing and maintaining plant material.

This program allows a person or group to contribute any amount of money to the Green fund. Donations are combined to raise money to purchase various trees and shrubs. This is an affordable way to show someone you care with a living "green" tribute for the community to share in their honor.

Plant material purchased will be installed throughout the community to help further the goal of "greening" Abington Township.

- Any resident, group, business or organization may make any size donation to the Green fund.
- Contributions may also be made in honor of, or in memory of, an individual or to celebrate a special occasion or event.
- An acknowledgement will be mailed to the donor and the designated recipient when applicable.

Tree Memorial

A Tree Memorial is designed to honor a person or celebrate a special occasion or event by having a tree planted in Abington Township as a living "green" tribute.

- The Township will order and purchase the tree upon receipt of contribution.
- Trees will be planted at optimum planting time (spring or fall).
- Requests for a tree location and tree species will be accommodated if possible; however, a specific location or species cannot be guaranteed.
- An acknowledgement will be mailed to both the donor and designated recipient.
- A name plate will be added to the Memorial Tree plaque situated at the Township Building.
- Memorial tree markers may be purchased separately by the donor.
